

Pregnancy & Oral Health

It is very important to visit your dentist during pregnancy. An increased incidence of dental health problems may occur during pregnancy.

- Hormonal changes lead to gum inflammation and bleeding
- Nausea and vomiting can cause erosion of the enamel
- Food cravings, especially of sweet food can result in an increase of tooth decay
- * Pregnant women often eat small frequent snacks such as crackers and other decay-promoting foods to counteract nausea, thereby increasing the risk of tooth decay

While it was once believed that the worst outcome of poor oral health was tooth loss, accumulating evidence suggests that gum disease during pregnancy may be a risk factor for the delivery of pre-term babies and babies with low birth weight


